## RECOMMENDATION

## BACKGROUND

Per TAM's Administrative Code, "Membership to each Committee shall be as recommended by the TAM Board Chair and approved by a majority of the full TAM Board."

Diane Furst sat on the TAM Board representing the Town of Corte Madera and was a member of the Programming and Projects Committee until she vacated her seat on this Committee when she stepped away from TAM at the end of her term as a Council member in July 2018. With the vacancy created by Ms. Furst's departure, the TAM Chair recommends a slight reorganization of both Committees.
