### Marin Countywide Coordinated Signal Modernization Plan

- TAM Awarded \$480,000 from MTC's Innovative Deployments to Enhance Arterials (IDEA) program
- Transit Signal Priority on arterial roadways, which modifies traffic signal timing when transit vehicles are near an intersection
- Improve traffic conditions & transit vehicle times through improved signal technology
- Signal Modernization Plan:
  - Inventory current signal technology
  - Develop signal modernization projects
  - Support transit, emergency vehicles, active transportation







#### RM3 Safe Routes to Transit & Bay Trail Program Call for Projects

\$50 million for competitive SR2TBT grant program to fund bicycle and pedestrian access improvements on and in the vicinity of state-owned toll bridges connecting to rail transit stations and ferry terminals. Applications received from Marin agencies:
